Who Are We?

The Cathedral Clinic aims to provide general practice medical services to migrant adults and children who have difficulty accessing medical care, including individuals with low / no income, and those who are without or are ineligible for, a medical card.

The clinic will be staffed by two qualified doctors in their final year of General Practice Specialist Training. It will be supervised by Dr Austin O' Carroll GP.

The clinic forms part of the Safetynet Service and will be run in conjunction with a number of agencies including the North Dublin City GP Training Programme (NDCGP), Young People at Risk (YPAR) and Pavee Point.

Where is the Clinic Located?

The Cathedral Clinic is located at Crosscare, 1 Cathedral Street, Dublin 1.

Hours of Operation

The Cathedral Clinic will be operational every Wednesday from 14:00 - 16:00 beginning 21st August 2013. The service will operate by appointment initially.
