SWAN Youth Service is funded through CDYSB under the Young Peoples Services and Facilities Fund to operate a youth service, which targets 10-21 year olds at risk; from the North Wall and North Strand areas. The Management Board wish to invite energetic and interested individuals to apply for the following post which will be situated in North Wall.

Full-time Youth Justice Worker:

A worker operating from a social change model of youth work is required for the above post to provide opportunities to young people in the North Wall area and to prevent their involvement in anti-social behaviour. This will require staff that can develop and coordinate the activities of The Swan Garda Youth Diversion Programme by engaging and supporting young people from North Wall in group work, one to one work, mentoring, advocacy, and issue based work.

A professionally endorsed qualification in Youth and Community Work is essential plus two years experience of working with young people at risk is desirable. **Or**

An equivalent professional qualification or relevant degree plus two years full time experience of working with young people at risk is essential. **Or**

Have worked as a full time youth worker without formal qualifications for at least 3 years.
